## Travis County looking for volunteer help to register voters

AUSTIN – The Travis County Tax Office invites all county residents 18 years of age and older to make a difference in their community by registering voters.

Texas law requires residents to take a free, one-hour training course that ends with the swearing in of participants as volunteer deputy registrars, the designation required to register voters. The tax office schedules monthly trainings throughout the county.

Registering voters is a nonpartisan activity.

The **Travis County Tax Office** annually collects more than \$4 billion in local property taxes for 132 local government entities and \$4 million in fines and fees for Justice of the Peace and County Courts at Law. The office registers and titles almost 1 million vehicles, registers over 700,000 voters, and supports elections for 201 local government entities. The Tax Office operates five locations in Travis County and many services are available online.
