DON'T MISS THE FEB. 3 VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE

Austin, TX - Register to vote for the March 4 Primary Election by Monday, Feb. 3. If you have moved since the last time you voted, you must update your voter registration record. Travis County voters can review their current voter registration record online at www.votetravis.com, or they may contact the Voter Registrar's office by telephone at (512) 854-9473.

"We want to be sure new Travis County residents and voters who have moved are registered on time for the election," said Travis County Tax Assessor-Collector and Voter Registrar, Bruce Elfant. "If you do not have an orange voter registration certificate with your current address, please contact our office to check your voter registration status."

How can you register or make changes to your voter registration?

- Come in person to one of the five tax office locations during business hours. Find maps and driving directions to all of our locations at www.traviscountytax.org.
- Mail an application and make sure the US postmark shows Feb. 3 or earlier. Find applications at area post offices, libraries or at www.traviscountytax.org.
- Go online to <https://txapps.texas.gov/tolapp/sos/SOSACManager> to update your name or address if you have moved within Travis County.
