DON'T MISS THE SEPTEMBER 15TH DEADLINE TO SIGN UP FOR YOUR 2014 eBILL

Austin, TX – Each year the Travis County Tax Office mails approximately 265,000 tax bills costing taxpayers just under \$116,000. Instead, property owners can use eBill, a convenient, environmentally-friendly and cost-saving option. The deadline to enroll for the 2014 tax bill is September 15, 2014.

“Most of us don’t start thinking about our bills until they arrive in the mailbox. Taking action now will help us make sure your bill is delivered quickly and accurately,” says Tax Assessor-Collector & Voter Registrar Bruce Elfant.

This year, the Travis County Tax Office worked with vendors to reduce eCheck fees to \$1 when paying at www.traviscountytax.org using a checking account. “Our goal is to increase the number of people who receive their tax bill online and pay online to further reduce costs and the impact on the environment,” says Elfant.
